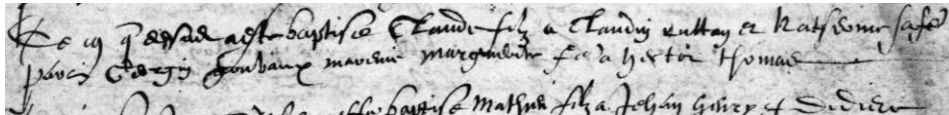


Figure 1. Baptism of Claude "Ruttan," Saint-Mihiel, 1590.

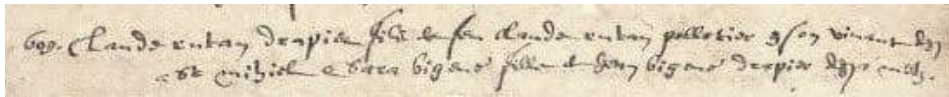


Figure 2. Marriage of Claude Rutan to Sara Bigene, Metz, 1613.

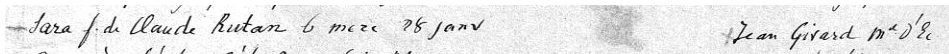


Figure 3. Baptism of Sara, daughter of Claude Rutan, Metz, 1615.

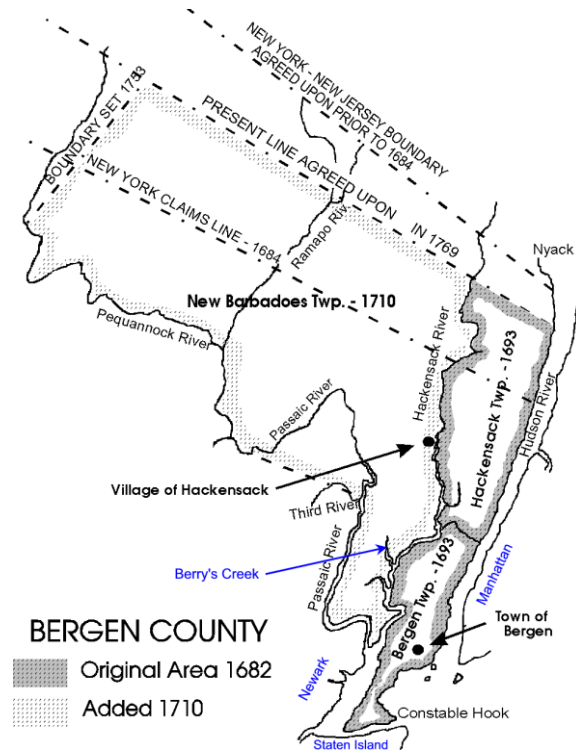


Figure 5. Bergen Co., N.J., as of 1682 and 1710.

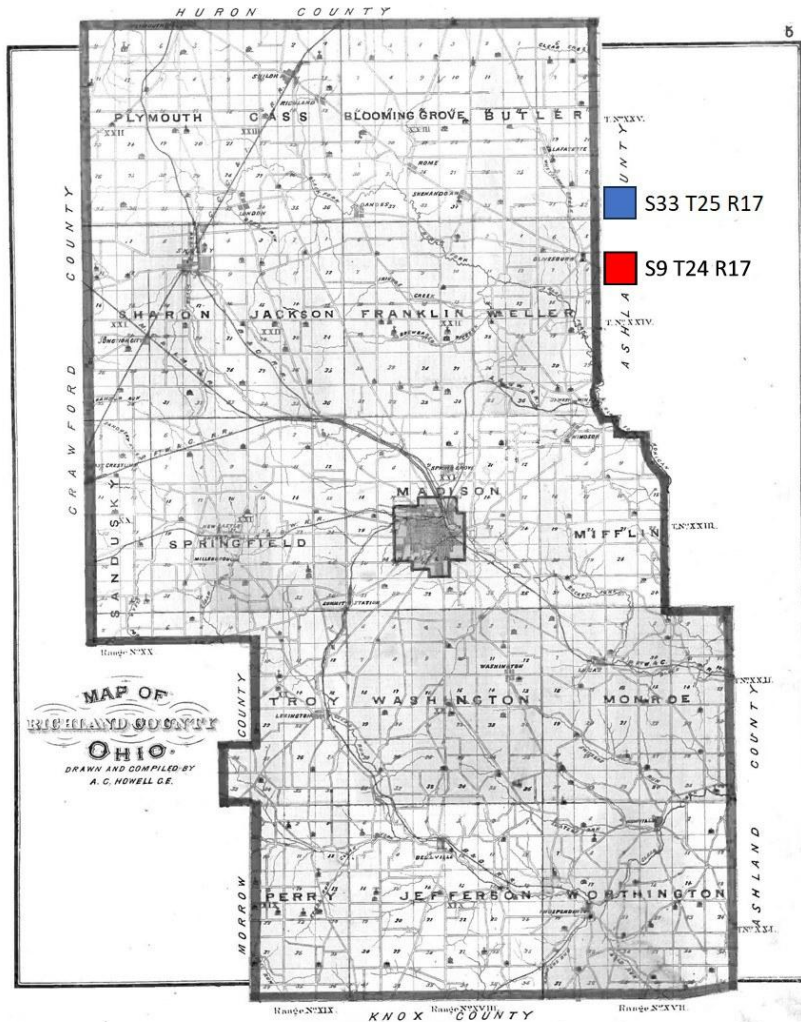


Figure 25. “Samuel<sup>5</sup> S33 Tract” is the SE quadrant of section 33 (blue) in Ashland, not Richland, Co., Ohio. Nicholas<sup>5</sup>’s tract is in section 9 (blue) directly south.

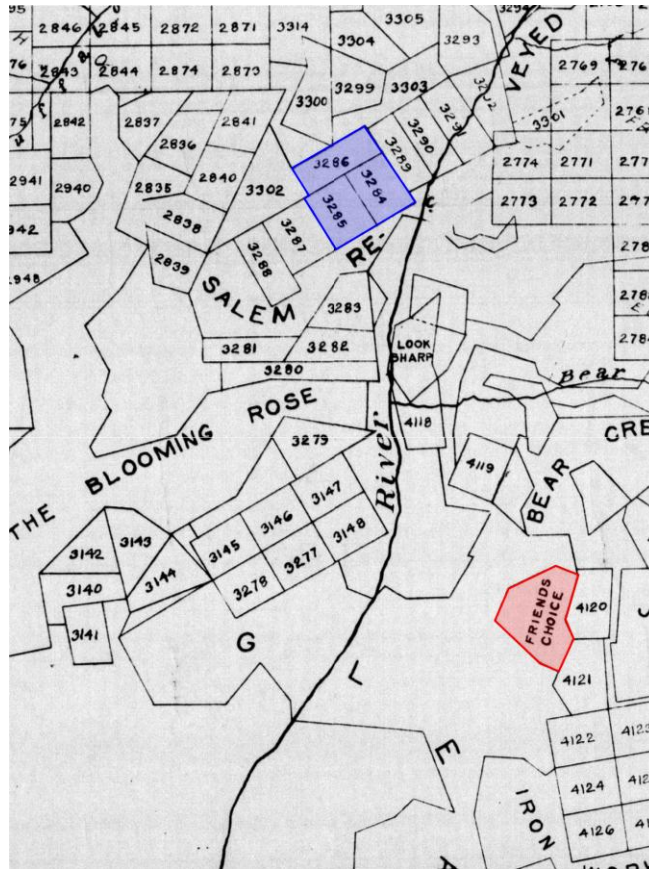


Figure 33. John<sup>4</sup> Rutan's properties in Allegheny (now Garrett) Co., Md.

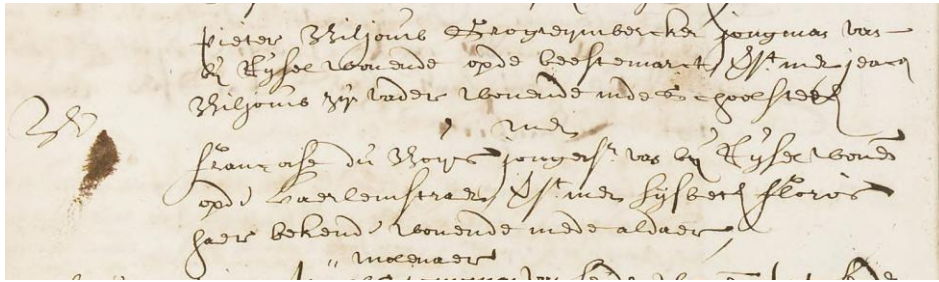


Figure 35. Marriage announcement of Pieter Biljou to Françoise du Boys, 9 Apr. 1649, Walloon Church, Leiden.

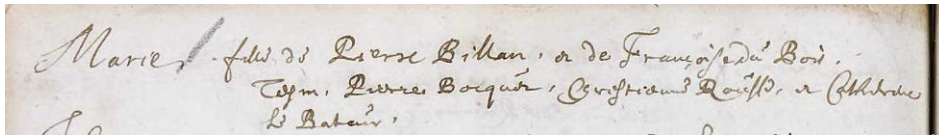


Figure 36. Baptism of Marie, daughter of Pierre Billau and Françoise Du Bois, 6 Mar. 1650, Walloon Church, Leiden.

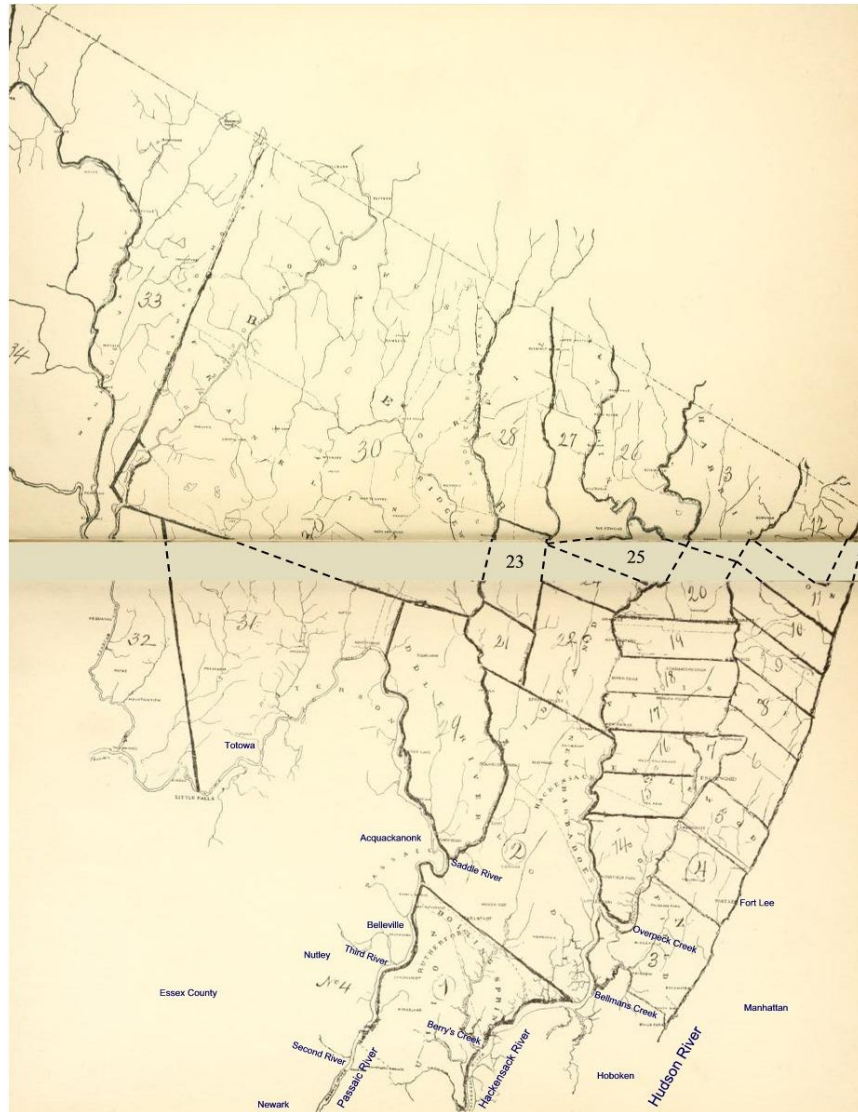


Figure 37. Major land grants in early New Jersey
